



**Division II Game Environment  
Award of Excellence**

**“Recognizing Achievement in Fostering a  
Positive Game Environment”**

Each NCAA Division II school and conference is eligible to submit its best game environment initiative, activity and/or event. Submissions must be received not later than **October 15, 2010**.

Submissions **must** include the following:

1. Overview (not more than one page) of the game environment initiative, activity or event. Identify the theme for the initiative, activity or event (civility, comfort and/or entertaining) and note the means in which the theme was used.
2. Explanation of how the game environment initiative, activity or event has made an impact on the campus or conference. Please cite specific examples.
3. Still photos (**not more than 10 submitted electronically on a disc**) highlighting the game environment initiative, activity or event.
4. Video, on DVD (if one exists), depicting the game environment initiative, activity or event.
5. Any flyers or other promotional materials related to the game environment initiative, activity or event (including any newspaper articles in the local or campus paper). Please submit this information electronically.

The game environment initiative, activity or event must be posted under “Ideas that Work” on [diicomunity.org/gameenvironment](http://diicomunity.org/gameenvironment) and must have occurred between August 2009 and September 2010.

The selection committee will announce the 22 conference winners, the one independent winner and the national winner by November 19, 2010.

Each conference winner and the independent winner will receive \$500.

The national winner will be recognized at the NCAA Convention in San Antonio, Texas in January 2011.
